

#### Task 3

### How does ONE news story link to another country or place?

This tasks aims to develop your explanation of links and international links.

### For example:

## "Boat carrying 200 African migrants sinks off Libyan coast while travelling 'towards Europe"

This news story is from August 2014. It is about people trying to migrate or move. They are trying to leave Africa and move to Europe. The boat they were travelling on sank in the Mediterranean Sea. The international links here are about the huge inequality in living conditions between Africa and Europe. In parts of Africa people may be fleeing war, disease or poverty. In contrast Europe just a few hundred miles away has a high standard of living.

An example of a piece of writing is below. Use it as a model. Can you spot the explained links? Count how many connectives have been used.

"In countries like Somalia, Libya and Mali there is currently conflict. This means that civilians often flee the fighting and move to refugee camps because they want to be safe. As a result thousands of people live in terrible conditions, with a lack of food, water, sanitation and healthcare. This leads to a poor quality of life because diseases spread quickly. Consequently many people hope to leave these places and move to Europe because they want to start a new life. Without money or passports these migrants often to cross Africa by land. This means facing a dangerous crossing of the Sahara desert because the heat and lack of water. Finally they must cross the Mediterranean Sea often in old and unseaworthy boats, which is where this news story ends in tragedy."
